We are delighted to announce a special trophy for **best participant and runner up** for the child who participates in maximum individual competitions, namely Classical dance, vocal, instrumental, Bhajan singing, mono acting, essay writing and Geeta chanting. The student who wins maximum prizes in these events will be eligible if he/she has participated in at least 5 events out of 7 events.

Specific themes and subjects are given wherever applicable in the individual rules for each competition. Please read them carefully to ensure that the participation content is as per the rules defined.

About Prempuri Ashram



"IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS"

1. **BEST SCHOOL TROPHY** – Each first prize will get 50 points, second prize 40 points, third prize 30 points and consolation prize 20 points. Best School will be awarded to the school that scores maximum number of points. First, Second and Third Prize winner will get awards.
2. **Participation is not chargeable.**
3. **Forms that do not have details about the school will be rejected. As we often have prize winners who are not present at the time of prize distribution and we are unable to trace the winners in the absence of full details about the school.**
4. School Principal must certify the details about the students along with their CONTACT NOS. In absence of certification, correct information especially about the standard of the student is not known.
5. **No participation will be allowed without school Identity Card & School Uniform.**
School uniform is not mandatory for Dance & Drama Competition.
6. Teachers are requested to accompany the students.
7. Please restrict the number of participants to the maximum permitted. We will be forced to permit participation only to the limit given by us. Rights of admission is reserved.
8. **Student can participate in more than one event only if timing of other events is not clashing.**
9. Performers will be called in alphabetical order of their name as stated in registration form eg. Aditya Mehta will come in "A" and Mehta Aditya will come in "M"
10. We have given the start time and end time of each event. These timings are based on 25 % increase in participation over last year. If the participation increased further there could be delay in timings.
11. Read the notice carefully regarding the items permitted especially in Classical Dance & Vocal. Students who perform other than items specified will not be considered for the competition. **No musicians will be provided by us.**

12. In event of large participation, the participants may be asked to sing or perform for a shorter time. The School should not take objection to the same. It is sufficient to judge the participants even with shorter performance. Child should be prepared accordingly.
13. Any kind of misconduct can lead to immediate disqualification.
14. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students found littering and damaging the venue.
15. For all Drawing and craft competitions, child must bring Drawing board and News paper.
16. Participants will be responsible for their own material.
17. Breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea would be provided to the children by the Ashram.
No charges will be levied for the same.
18. Eatables are allowed only on Terrace.
19. No Student / Participant / Teachers / Principal would be allowed to influence the decisions of Judges and check the Judge sheet.
20. Teachers who accompany the students for the competition will be honored at the time of Prize Distribution. This will be based on the participation in maximum events by the school.
21. Judges and organizers decision will be final & binding.

Description	:	Participants must choose an alphabet given below in rules and bring only one object starting with that alphabet which the child can hold and talk about it. Eg. If the letter C is chosen, child can bring a camera OR crayon OR clock etc. then talk about that object. Object must be non-life.
Rules	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Child must speak for 2 minutes. <u>In English or Hindi only.</u> ➢ Object to be selected from alphabets D, J, L, S, V ➢ (Hindi) द, ज, ल, स, व ➢ Only one object to be brought and performed. ➢ Uniform & school identity card is compulsory. ➢ Marks are given on speech by child and not the object selected. Child should announce the alphabet and object selected.
